



Cycling Friendly Secondary School Development Fund

What is the fund?

The development fund, supported by Transport Scotland, supports Scottish secondary schools to take a leading role in improving their facilities and increasing opportunities for pupils to travel to school by bike.

We largely offer capital funding which can be spent on long term assets such as bikes or equipment. Some examples of successfully funded projects include:

- Bike maintenance equipment
- Bike and bike accessories such as helmets and D-locks
- Small facilities improvements such as signage

Why apply?

The development fund is a great way to access investment in making your secondary school cycling friendly. Creating opportunities for students to cycle brings so many positive benefits for young people: building their confidence, supporting disengaged students and creating projects that pupils can take ownership of.

How much is available?

The grant provides funding of up to £4,000 per secondary school.

Who can apply?

The fund is open to all secondary schools in Scotland who are committed to increasing opportunities for pupils and staff to cycle.
